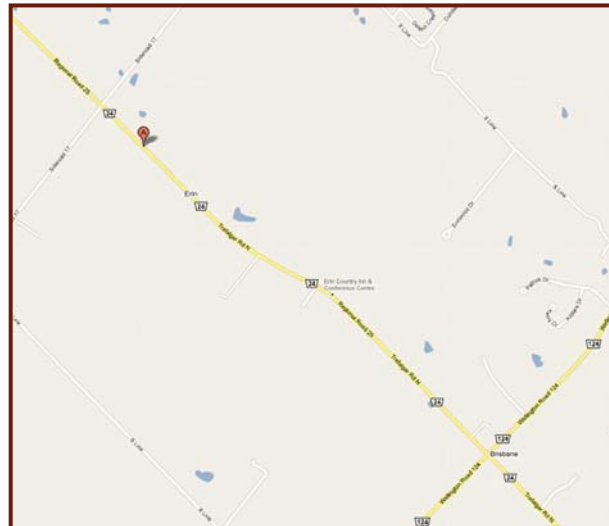
- 27 acres, 5 large paddocks, rustic cedar fenced;

## 2011 SUMMER DAY CAMPS FOR THE HORSE CRAZY KID!



**Session One: August 2~5** (4 days no sleep over)

**Session Two: August 8~12** (5 days, one nite sleepover)

**Session Three: August 15~19** (5 days, one nite sleepover)

**Session Four: August 22~26** (5 days, one nite sleepover)

The five-day Sessions are Monday to Friday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The four-day Session starts on Tuesday. Early drop-off and late pick up is available.

Greyden Summer riding camps are specifically designed for children between 7 and 14, who are keen on learning to ride safely and how to care for the animals.

### WHAT TO EXPECT AT DAY CAMP

Everyday our riders will have two hours of riding. This instructional riding time (not just a trail ride) is when we teach the new equestrians proper control and safety with horses in a group riding situation.

As the week progresses the student learns more about being a good rider and readying them for our horse show, and demonstration on each Friday afternoon.

Our horse show is a fun show to "show off" to loved ones and visitors what each camper learned during the week. Each camper will be awarded a Certificate of Accomplishment at the end of each session.

Please note that Session One has a one hour riding time and no horse show or sleep over.

**COSTS:** Session One is only \$200 (a \$264 value!) ... this is our value added camp, with two free lessons; Sessions Two, Three and Four are \$250/week.

## SESSION ONE AUGUST 2-5 - PONY PALS



A value added camp for first time and beginner riders from ages 6 to 10. The camp geared as the first step for new and first-time riders into the world of horses, to slowly get acquainted to the sport of riding. The focus is on fun with horses – games, crafts and lots of laughter. Tuesday to Friday children have half day of riding, the other half day will be crazy fun time! Face painting, jewelery making, dream catchers and lots of water sports! A fun guest visitor will show us some magic and animal balloon making too! There is no sleepover or mock horse show this session.

## SESSION TWO AUGUST 8-12 - SCRAPBOOK WEEK



A themed 5 day with sleepover craft camp for the horse crazy kids ages 7 to 14. We ride twice a day, everyday and spend lunch time working on our books. Everyday we will take pictures of our events, riding with our favorite pony, and build a scrap book with our guest artist, Tracy Squires of Page Creations. We will complete the scrapbook by the end of the week and have something to take home to cherish for years to come. It's way cool, our most favorite camp, and it fills up fast!

## SESSION THREE AUGUST 15-19 - FULL IMMERSION HORSE WEEK



This camp is designed for riders 7 to 14 years old, both beginners and improvers with some prior riding experience. Spending 80% of our time with horses, the focus is on improving our skills on horseback and in the stables. Same great five day with sleepover, riding camp just more horsey than crafty. A quiz – a challenge – games and prizes! And of course, lots of horse fun.

## SESSION FOUR AUGUST 22-26 - BOOT CAMP



A camp for those riders already riding elsewhere or in our existing lesson programs. Geared for the novice rider already mastered walk, trot and some cantering. A great camp for those that might want to show with us some day! Quizzes, contests and team activities. Showing prep, etiquette and practice sessions will be our focus throughout the days.
